

Identification: Know these terms, concepts, and positions and how they relate to other concepts and positions and what ramifications each may have. Also, know the arguments for each position and each thinker's take on these positions. Any of these terms, concepts or positions could appear in a multiple choice, true-false, or short answer question. Also, know which thinkers are associated with which positions and be able to identify passages from these authors. Questions on this and other sections in the exam may be drawn from the readings, class lectures, and class notes.

Short answer essay questions will require you to define, discuss, or analyze some position, concept or argument relating to ethics or a particular ethical position. These answers will be approximately a paragraph in length.

Be prepared to write clearly and precisely on any of the ethical positions or problems discussed in class. Also, be prepared to analyze one or more of the arguments we have seen in class.

You are not allowed to copy from the notes or text. You are expected to reference whatever you quote. You are allowed to consult your notes and text during the exam.
